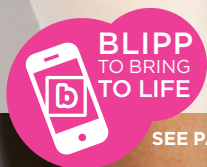

A turban can transform a bad hair day into a hipster moment. Rock it like you mean it, so don't skip the makeup or the fab outfit.

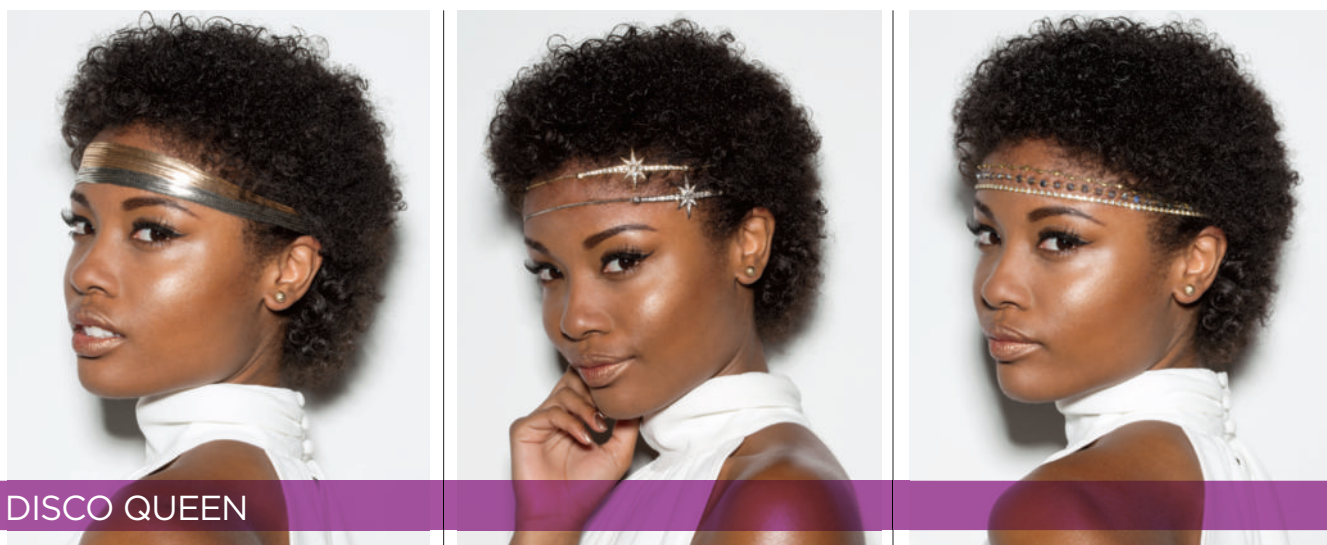
